

Volunteer: PARTS ORGANIZER/CLEANER

With all the donations coming in, we need some mighty talented organizers and cleaners!

The donations that come in are often quite dirty and it is incredibly helpful to have them cleaned up before we use them. This is a great way to become familiar with bike parts and shop organization, and is a great stepping stone to eventually working on bikes.

Primary responsibilities:

- Clean bike parts (derailleurs, shifters, brakes, etc)
- Sift through broken or unusable parts
- Organize bins as labeled

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Friendly, honest and trustworthy
- Strong support for the mission of the Bicycle Collective

Time commitment: Minimum 45 minutes on assigned work day.

Length of Appointment: While there is no required length of appointment, we appreciate regular attendance and knowing in advance when volunteers will be joining us. If you want to move on to become a Volunteer Mechanic, you must volunteer as a Parts Organizer/Cleaner for 6 hours.

Benefits: If you have no previous bike mechanic experience, but are hoping to learn some skills, this is the best place to start. Not only will you be helping us tremendously, you'll become familiar with the various bike parts. If desired, you can begin learning bicycle mechanics after volunteering for 6 hours.
